The Bishop English Country Dance -- Longways
Record HMV 8665

Set: Contra lines for as many as will or for sets of
~~3~~ ³ ~~four~~ ^{three} couples. Triple minor

First man casts away from set and enters set between
second and third man (second man moves up);
then sets to third lady (she also sets); turns
third lady once around and returns to second
man's position.

First lady casts away from set and enters set between
second and third lady (second lady moves up);
then sets to third man (he also sets); turns
third man once around and returns to second
lady's position.

Second man turns first man up through center of set and
around to first man's position (second man acts as
pivot) while second lady turns first lady in same
manner.

Third couple gypsies once around to place while first and
second couples are turning at top of set.

All three couples join six hands around and circle half-
way.

Third couple turns the first couple at the top while the
second couple gypsies.

All three couples join six hands around and circle half-
way back to proper side of set.

Repeat dance as many times as length of set will permit.

Note: #1 couple moves down set. (active)

#2 and #3 move up set. (inactive)

When inactives reach top of set, they must wait out
twice through the dance before beginning the dance
as an active couple.

#1 couple must dance with a ghost at the bottom and
then wait out one more turn of the dance.

Note: A gypsy is done with couple facing each other arms
outstretched and dancing 8 light walking steps to
the left around each other circling back to place.
