

BUGARKA

(Serbia)

- Background:** This is a dance for both men and women from the village of Zhagubitsa (North East Serbia, Vlach area). The dance is performed with instrumental accompaniment. The dance pattern includes 4 figures.
- Rhythm:** 2/4 meter
- Formation:** Open circle; belt hold.
- CD:** Serbian-Bulgarian CD, Band 5

FIGURE I

- 1 Tap on R in place (ct 1&), tap on R in place (ct 2&).
- 2 Step on R in place (ct 1), step on L across in front of R(ct &); step on R in place (ct 2), step on L in place (ct &).
- 3 Step on R in place (ct 1), large step on L across in front of R(ct &); step on R in place (cts 2&).
- 4 Jump onto L slightly to the L (ct 1&); jump onto R, slightly to the R (ct 2&).
- 5 Step on L in place (ct 1), step on R across in front of L(ct &); step on L in place (ct 2), step on R in place (ct &).
- 6 Step on L in place (ct 1), step on R across in front of L (ct &); step on L in place (cts 2 &).

FIGURE II

- 1 Tap on R in place (cts 1&), tap on R in place (cts 2&).
- 2 Step on R in place (ct 1), step on L across in front of R (ct &); step on R in place (ct 2), step on L in place (ct &).
- 3 Step on R in place (ct 1), large step on L across in front of R (ct &); step on R in place (ct 2), step on L in place (ct &).
- 4 Jump onto L slightly to the L (ct 1), tap on R (ct&); Jump onto R slightly to the R (ct 1), tap on L (ct&)
- 5 Step on L in place (ct 1), step on R across in front of L(ct &); step on L in place (ct 2), step on R in place (ct &).
- 6 Step on L in place (ct 1), step on R across in front of L (ct &); step on L in place (cts 2 &).

FIGURE III

- 1 Tap on R in place (cts 1&), tap on R in place (cts 2&).
- 2 Step on R in place (ct 1), step on L across in front of R (ct &); step on R in place (ct 2), step on L in place (ct &).
- 3 Step on R in place (ct 1), large step on L across in front of R (ct &); step on R in place (ct 2), step on L in place (ct &).
- 4 Jump onto L, simultaneously jump onto R behind the L (cts 1 &); jump onto R, simultaneously jump onto L behind the R (cts 2 &)
- 5 Step on L in place (ct 1), step on R across in front of L(ct &); step on L in place (ct 2), step on R in place (ct &).
- 6 Step on L in place (ct 1), step on R across in front of L (ct &); step on L in place (cts 2 &).

FIGURE IV

- 1 Tap on R in place (ct 1&), tap on R in place (ct 2&).
- 2 Step on R in place (ct 1), step on L across in front of R(ct &); step on R in place (ct 2), step on L in place (ct &).
- 3 Step on R in place (ct 1), large step on L across in front of R (ct &); step on R in place (ct 2), step on L in place (ct &).
- 4 Jump onto L slightly to the L (ct 1&); jump onto R, slightly to the R (ct 2&).
- 5 Step on L in place (ct 1), step on R across in front of L(ct &); step on L in place (ct 2), step on R in place (ct &).
- 6 Step on L in place (ct 1), step on R across in front of L (ct &); step on L in place (cts 2), step on R in place.
- 7 Step on L across in front of R (ct 1), step on R in place (ct &), step on L in place (cts 2&).
