Dance directions to

"JESSICA POLKA"

STARTING POSITION: Couples in varsouvienne position, Lady on Gent's right, progressing counterclockwise around floor. (Gent and Lady use same footwork throughout)

MEAS. 1-2 Touch left heel forward and close (cts. 1-2, Meas. 1)
Touch right toe back and close (cts. 3-4, Meas. 1)
Touch right toe forward and close (cts. 1-2, Meas. 2)
(or kick right foot forward—this is optional)
Touch left toe to side and forward (cts. 3-4, Meas. 2)

MEAS. 3-4 Starting on left foot — four steps forward (cts. 1-2-3-4, Meas. 3)
(cts. 1-2-3-4, Meas. 4)

REPEAT ENTIRE DANCE

NOTE: This dance can be done by couples, or by any number of persons arm in arm, or in a Conga line.

CUES

Left heel, close
Right toe, close
Right toe, close
Side, front
Two-step, two-step, two-step, two-step
