Jane Farwell, the originator of Oglebay Institute's Folk Dance Camps in 1941, returns to help us celebrate our 30th Anniversary. The Folk Dance Movement has spread throughout West Virginia and beyond largely due to Jane's enthusiasm and talent. She makes folk dances come alive through her captivating personality. Jane lived in Germany for a number of years and is now at home in Folklore Village, Dodgeville, Wisconsin where she sponsors an annual Christmas camp.

Camp Russel is located within Oglebay Park, seven miles east of Wheeling on West Virginia Route 88 North. From the West on I-70, take the first turnoff, Mt. DeChantal Exit, after leaving the tunnel. From the east on I-70, take Mt. DeChantal to West Virginia Route 88 North. After entering Oglebay Park grounds, take first road on the right to CAMP RUSSEL.

Supervision of children is the responsibility of parents. Teens, unless accompanied by an adult, should check in and out with the camp director. Oglebay Park has facilities for swimming, tennis, golf, riding, fishing and boating. The dining room in Wilson Lodge, is open all year.

What To Bring Bring your own bedding plus a pillow, if you need one. A few bedding sets may be rented for \$1.00 per night. Also bring comfortable dance clothes, low-heeled shoes, costumes. Raincoat and flashlight can be useful.
