#### **David Henry**

Instructor of Balkan and European folk dancing at Barnard College, New York. Mr. Henry has taught master classes at Brooklyn College, Swarthmore, Queensboro Community, The University of Pennsylvania, Rochester, Cornell, East Tennessee State, and Rutgers-Newark. In 1970, he taught for three weeks in Switzerland. He will return to Main Folk Dance Camp in the summer.

#### **Al Schwinabart**

American square dance caller, round dance teacher, and folk dancer from Elk Garden, West Virginia. Al regularly calls for Oglebay camps and other groups in Maryland, West Virginia, and Pennsylvania. His popularity stems from a happy personality and an excellent choice of new material, couple rounds, and mixers. Besides teaching, Al operates a 770 acre farm in eastern West Virginia and is a Kemper Insurance Company salesman.

### Directions to Camp Russel

Camp Russel is located within Oglebay Park, seven miles east of Wheeling on West Virginia Route 88 North. From the West on I-70, take the first turnoff, Mt. De Chantal Exit, after leaving the tunnel. From the East on I-70, take Mt. De Chantal Exit to West Virginia Route 88 North. After entering Oglebay Park grounds, take first road on the right to CAMP RUSSEL.
