Directions for EIDE RATAS will be found in "Folk Dances For All", the little \$1.00 orange-colored book that most of you now have. And the Imperial record 1007 listed for the dance is the one that has WOODEN SHOES on the reverse side, which makes it a very nice buy indeed.

SARAJEVKA KOLO is out of Folk Dancer Album #3, "Dances of Jugoslavia", mentioned in the bulletin of three weeks ago. The other KOLO we are now doing out of this album is NEBESCO KOLO. You will also find directions for all six kolos in this album right in the album, so that if you are interested in kolos, this album will be an excellent buy.

You will find several recordings of ST. BERNARD WALTZ besides the London given above. Amongst others, there is a Coral, and there is a Columbia. They're all good.
