Dear Judge Wolff:

The petition, signed by you and other interested parties, requesting the City of Dayton to refrain from demolishing the building located at the Community Country Club that is presently being used by dance groups has been referred to me for reply.

Please be advised that we have made an investigation of this situation and have reports on hand from Mr. Dan Wagner and Acting Director of the Department of Welfare, Dr. H. H. Williams. The conclusion has been reached that the building should be continued in operation until it is replaced by some other facility which will serve the public in a similar manner.

By copy of this letter, I am requesting the interested Divisions to take no action to dispose of this building or to alter it in any way which would prevent its use by dance groups until specifically authorized by me.

You will be interested to know that there has been a recommendation made that a building be located in Triangle Park which would provide the same kind of service now being provided by the building in question. This recommendation is under study and a decision on the matter will be made at a later date. In the meantime, you may assure all interested parties that the building at Community will be continued in use and available for dance groups.
