At that time he was still located in Pittsburg at Duquesne University with the Tamburitzans as their librarian and choreographer. (This is the student group that will perform at Wilmington College, Wilmington, Ohio, in connection with their International Festival, March 2, 3, and 4. The "Tammies" appear at 1:00 and 8:15 P.M.) At present Dick is at Harvard. This is his third year in the Graduate School and, at the moment, he is pursuing his Doctorate in Slavic Studies and doing exceedingly well! It would take a book to tell all the wonderful things about him, but even then his simple charm, his kindly manner, and his ready wit might still be what we remember most and like the best about him. Dick is just past thirty and yet during the past twelve or more years he has headed the programming of six or seven gigantic Folk Festivals in St. Paul, Minnesota, his original home, and in Pittsburgh. He has been to Yugoslavia on three extended trips during which time he has collected much of the material he uses in his workshops. The last time I checked, it took all my fingers and toes (and I still have ten of each) to count the number of languages he speaks, reads, and writes fluently, and to this has been added Russian, I believe, since he has gone to Harvard. Oh yes, one more thing, he likes to play the recorder, so bring yours if you wish. He is not only a skillful dancer but also a truly excellent teacher. Don't miss DICK CRUM!
