

MINUTES OF ANNUAL MEETING OF MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCERS (1964)

The annual meeting of the Miami Valley Folk Dancers was held at Burkhardt Community Center on 16 January 1964. The meeting was called to order at 8:35 p.m. by the Chairman of the Council, Florence Seger. Of the 41 members of the group, 27 were present. Also present were Mike Solomon and Grace Wolff.

The minutes of the previous annual meeting were read and approved.

Rosemarie Dennehy distributed copies of the Treasurer's report, a copy of which is attached. This report indicated that as of 1 January 1964 the group had a total of \$248.40 in the treasury.

The first item of business was election of three Council members to replace those whose term had been served. The three retiring Council members were Rosemarie Dennehy, Libby Ogdan and Mitzi Manny. A nominating ballot was taken. The six members who received the highest number of ballots were Judy Weaver, Jewel Steed, Evan Larkin, Steve Kloeter, Frank Hart and Ann Ballinger. Evan Larkin declined the nomination. Another ballot was cast, and the three new Council members who were elected were Jewel Steed, Steve Kloeter and Ann Ballinger, each of whom is to serve for two years.

There followed some discussion of where the club would meet on the 23rd of January, as the floor at Burkhardt is still undergoing repairs. Mike Solomon made arrangements for the group to dance on that evening at Lohrey Center. Florence Seger said she would notify those persons of the Ski Club (for which the group had danced on 15 January) who had expressed an interest in coming to the Thursday night dance sessions of MVFD.

Arrangements for the weekend with Jane Farwell as teacher are well under way (weekend of 25 and 26 January 1964). Grace announced that all MVFD members are welcome to come to the party being held in honor of Jane at Lohrey Center on 20 January.

There was some discussion of the possibility of having a Swedish Day some Saturday or Sunday in March, for which we would plan a smorgasbord and Grace would teach some Swedish dances. Other dancers in the area would be invited to come. This would be planned as a money-making project.

There being no further business, a motion was made by Bob Manny and seconded by Pat Hennessey to adjourn, which was done at 9:55 p.m.
