April 30, 1969

Special Council Meeting was called st the home of John Hunter, April 30; 1969, all Council Members were present.

Changes, which needed to be made in our Rules and Reulations were discussed and readied for the groupes approval. These changes were mailed to each member. (Paragraph E on the Dance director was deleted, and in turn changed reading of the second paragraph on Council to read; The Council shall determine such matters as frequency of dance sessions, general program policies, delinquency regulations, and anything pertaining to the welfare of the organization, provided such action shall not be in conflict with the policies of the Bureau Of Recreation. A represtative of the Bureau of Recreation shall be, ex-officio, an advisory member of the Council. The Council shall be responsible for other major decisions, with the approval of the membership.)

On May 22; 1969 motion was made by Florence Seger and second by Wayne Cheek that we adopt the changes. Motion carried.

A discussion on the clarification of the Associate Member followed, with the result of deleting of two sentences from the Membership papagraph.
