Dear Miami Valley Folk Dancers,

Summer is here and many of us will be gone from time to time, so please check the assignment book to be sure you are not scheduled to do a Thursday program when you cannot be here: Cheeks, July 8; Cantrell, July 15; Nellises, July 22; Steeds, July 29; Wolff, August 5; Laycock, August 12; Donleys, August 19; Stovalls, August 26. Please contact John if you wish to teach a dance you learned at a camp or weekend within the last few months. Meg is trying for an Hungarian Ethnic Sunday in October, and George Tomov will be here November 13 and 14 for our Yugoslav Weekend. Do save both days. The Pappases are chairing the weekend.

There will be a "wish you well in your new home" party for the Hunters, given by the MVFD, on August 4 about 8 o'clock at our house. Ann will plan dancing on the patio. If it rains we'll circle round the punch bowl indoors. August 29 is our annual picnic at the Harts. It's a dance and covered dish and everyone always has a good time. Leona Lybarger has invited us to her farm. September 17 or 18 is being considered. Details later.

September through October 7, teaching sessions will be 8 to 8:30, after which the 7:30 to 8:30 schedule will be resumed. Thanks to everyone for all the nice things you do--programs, food, parties, et al!
