Established a meeting date of June 12 at 7:30 P.M. at Bruce's home to evaluate where we are, and what our plans are for the remainder of the year.

The results of the program committee's survey were discussed. The survey showed that preferences for workshops were: #1 - Israeli; #2 - English; #3 - Scottish, and #4 - German. It was agreed that since we had primarily a line-dance workshop last spring, we would have a Scottish workshop this fall, and probably an Israeli workshop next spring. It was felt that a Scottish workshop would attract a larger number of people than an English workshop.

The council selected Carolyn Stovall to chair the fall workshop. Possible dates of October 7-8 and October 21-22 were chosen. The folkdance groups in Columbus and Cincinnati will be checked for possible conflicting events on these dates. No final decision was made on the ~~spring~~ workshop.
