Dear Mady,

This letter is in response to your request that all Michael Solomon Dance Clubs put in writing their suggestions as to how the pavilion improvements (in particular, the exhaust fans) can be paid for.

The Miami Valley Folk Dancers' council met to discuss this issue and brought forth the following suggestions and comments:

1. Our council feels strongly that the money now being held in abeyance for a new north pavilion should be used for improvements on the Solomon Pavilion, since there is no assurance of any other pavilion being constructed in the near future.
2. We could once again collect 25¢ per member per dance until the debt is paid.
3. Money could be withdrawn from the existing treasury of each individual club.

It must be emphasized, however, that because of the rules and regulations under which our club governs itself, it's council members cannot agree to any type of payment without going before the club membership for approval. Also, the third suggestion would have to be a very last choice method of payment as far as the folk dancers are concerned. We operate on a yearly budget and must maintain a sizeable balance to ensure payment of our workshops. These are quite expensive and are not always self-supporting.

Other suggestions that grew out of our meeting were a request for several estimates of the work, and that these be shared with the supporting clubs before the work is begun; and investigation into roof insulation with circulating type fans vs. exhaust fans; and aiming for a spring completion date to allow time for a more thorough investigation.

Certainly, the Miami Valley Folk Dancers are supportive of your committee's work and will help to accomplish it's goals.
