

FIFTH REGULAR MEETING OF MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCERS' COUNCIL

December 2, 1980

PLACE: Home of Tony VanDer Sluijs - 7:30 p.m.  
ATTENDING: All Council members

The secretary's report was approved as submitted.

The treasurer reported a balance of \$107.90 in checking and petty cash, and \$1,284.04 in our savings account. The largest bill was for repair of the record player - \$79.73. The Toni Francis Workshop cleared \$107.08. 67 people were present for the meal. We had an attendance of 77 in the afternoon and 67 in the evening.

OLD BUSINESS:

Liability Insurance will not be available for the club.

Dennis Boxell will come for a workshop on March 21 and 22, 1981. His fee is \$325.00 plus transportation. It was recommended that we purchase his plane ticket immediately in order to get the Super Saver price.

The project to formulate a folk dance terminology booklet has been dropped.

Ed Anderson's two letters will go out with the notice of our annual meeting for consideration by the membership.

Reports on inquiries to various teachers for our 1981 fall workshop were as follows:

Jeanne reported Dan Karachzum quoted a price of \$500.00, which was felt to be too high. She had no other suggestions for a Russian workshop.

Carolyn Stovall did not wish to contact Karen Gottier asking for price.

Sam read a letter from Bea Montrose and she would come for \$200.00 plus expenses, air fare or car. She lives near New York.

Several later suggestions had been given to Carole. Bruce Cantrell suggested Ann Richens for an Irish workshop. Her price would no doubt be low. John Pappas recommended we consider Tom Bozigian for an Armenian workshop sometime. Jeanne has gone to one of his workshops and thinks he is excellent. However, he lives in California and travel expense would be too high to consider for 1981 since we are having Dennis Boxell.

After discussion, motion was made and carried that we have Bea Montrose for the fall workshop 1981. We would ask her to do an International workshop, which would better balance our workshops for 1981. Ann Ballinger was asked to chair this weekend and accepted.

NEW BUSINESS:

Louise Van Vliet would like permission to advertise the spring workshop in a quarter page ad in Viltis. Cost would be \$40.00. Motion was made and carried that this could be done providing it would appear before the first of March. It was also suggested that, along with Louise's name to contact in the ad, Sam's name also appear.

New Year's Eve Party: Sam reported he checked regarding facilities and there are no problems. The Program Committee will take care of the program of dancing. Carole will ask Ralph and Teresa Guess to be in charge of food. Don and Peg Eltzroth were suggested and also Rick Rutan and Melinda Marsh. The Chairmen in charge of food may solicit all the help they need. It was suggested they appoint someone to be in charge of snacks and set-ups. Carole will ask Charlie to be in charge of coffee. Cost for guests will be \$3.00 per person. There will be no charge to members.
