

SPECIAL MEETING MVFD COUNCIL

A special meeting of the MVFD Council was held March 26 at 7:00 p.m. at Solomon Pavilion to review our Balkan Workshop. All members were present.

Treasurer reported we took in \$1,751.00 and spent \$1,350.36. Our security guard is still to be paid \$32.70. We owe \$206.40 on records, but there is still money to come in from their sale. The record company advised we should keep 20% from the sale of records which would be \$76.60. Dennis thought the 20% profit was to be his, but was agreeable to handling it however we wished. John suggested we split the profit with Dennis, which would amount to \$38.30. However, since Dennis made some long distance calls, it was suggested we wait until those bills come in and pay them out of Dennis' portion.

Krainz's turned in a bill of \$20.00 for gas and electricity for baking etc.

Our club will keep 6 records from the weekend at a total cost of \$33.75.

Tri-City was discussed and it was agreed the club would pay \$4.50 per member for those who attend. As Sam will not be there, it was suggested each member attending pay his way and be reimbursed by the club afterward. Tony will keep a record of those attending. Charlie will teach Pod Borem at Tri-City.

Peggy read a letter from Ed Anderson suggesting we set a closing time for the club, so that it is definite for the people who have the program. It was decided that we would continue having a closing time of 11:00 p.m. and if others wish to stay later, they would have to make arrangements to close up.
