

FOURTH REGULAR MEETING OF MVFD COUNCIL

September 7, 1982

PLACE: Peggy Booher's home - 7:30 p.m.

ATTENDING: John Pappas, Sam Ballinger, Peggy Booher, and Marjorie Darragh

Meeting was called to order by Chairman and minutes of last meeting approved as corrected. Treasurer reported \$1,650.17 in the treasury including \$240.00 taken in for the coming workshop.

Plans for the workshop with Tom Bosigan on Sept. 17, 18, and 19, are coming along very well. Ann Ballinger has taken care of the caterers and also assigned people to handle the snacks. John reported arrangements have been made for Bomberger Center for Friday evening, all day Saturday, and Sunday afternoon.

John advised Jeanne Gulden has offered to bring our record file list up to date with the use of her home computer.

Ray Gottschall has requested the use of our records and record player for the Camp Kern workshop in October. Council approved.

In discussing future workshops, Peggy advised some members felt we could use local people for teaching and re-teach some of the old dances we seldom do. It was mentioned bringing in professional teachers for workshops twice a year helped stimulate our club as well as contributing to other dance groups in the area who also attend our workshops. We do use our local talent for our Ethnic Sundays and for our Thursday night teaching. It was suggested that we continue our present schedule of workshops as long as we can afford to do so. If costs and plane fares continue to rise, it might be necessary to have local teachers occasionally for a workshop.

Peggy reported we still have no response for a teacher for a Russian workshop next spring. Several members of our club have attended workshops by Jaap Leegwater from the Netherlands and recommend him highly. He teaches Bulgarian dances and also instruments. Peggy suggested we try and get him for the spring workshop in 1983 as he will be in this country from April to September next year. She will get more details regarding price etc.

John announced the Ethnic Sundays as follows: September - Turkish, October - review Armenian, November - British, December - Russian, January - Annual meeting, and February - Israeli.

Peggy donated the \$35.00 she was paid for a group dancing a Greek dinner to the club to buy five minute tapes.

John asked for suggestions for people to chair the New Year's Eve party and Puterbaughs and Gessels were mentioned. The Rowlands were suggested for the Pre-New Year's Eve party if that evening has not already been assigned by the Refreshment Committee.

Next meeting for the Council will be December 7 at John Pappas' home.
