

FIFTH REGULAR MEETING OF MVFD COUNCIL

December 7, 1982

PLACE: John Pappas' home - 7:30 p.m.

ATTENDING: All council members present

Minutes of last meeting were read and approved. Treasurer reported we had \$1,791.46 in the bank the end of November. He reported we lost \$93.87 on the Tom Bosigan workshop.

Peggy Booher reported she had no answer from Jaap Leegwater, of the Netherlands, for the spring workshop. She will continue to follow up on this.

Peg Eltzroth reported she had two replies for the fall workshop. They are: (1) James M. Roncevic, who lives in Pennsylvania, will charge around \$300.00 for the weekend. (2) Sunny Bloland, who lives in California, will charge \$350.00 for the weekend. They both teach Romanian dancing, and of course, transportation would be in addition to their charge. We are considering the last of September or the first of October for this workshop.

Marilyn Bishop announced last Thursday night that she is interested in starting a daytime group for folk dancing. She also talked to John about it and the possibility of using the MVFD equipment. We understand only three people signed up as interested so far. It is possible she may bring this up at the annual meeting. Council decided the use of the equipment would have to be approved by the entire club.

The Puterbaughs have accepted the chairmanship for the New Year's eve party. Peggy Booher, who was chairman one year, will help advise them. Sam also listed the set-ups needed, which he handled last year. Peg Eltzroth reported the charge for Lohrey will be around \$86.50 paid ten days in advance. We want to have the center until 3 a.m., which may add a little to the cost. Council decided there will be no charge for members and \$3.50 each for guests and associate members.

Our Mini-New Year's eve party was discussed and it was decided to give the Refreshment Committee \$30 to \$40 to spend for that evening. Members may also volunteer to bring cookies or snacks.

Annual meeting will be January 9 at 3 p.m. John will issue a news letter to notify members.

It was decided Tri-City will be March 19-20 at Camp Kern. Suggestions for someone to chair the event were as follows: Rick and Mel, Lilly Ulrich, Harry Khamis, Carolyn Stovall, Toni Francis, Gitta Reck, and Leslie Hyll. We plan to begin about 1:00 p.m. Saturday, have a Saturday night dinner, late night snack, and Sunday breakfast.

Council also modified the sheet we give to interested people regarding our club, such as our classes, ethnic Sundays, workshops etc., and will have it reprinted.

It was suggested to ask Pat Hennessey to audit the books.

The International Festival will be May 26, 27, and 28. John wanted to know how Council felt about our club dancing there again this year. No decision was made.

The Square dance convention will be in Dayton on May 5-6-7, 1984. It is possible we might be able to plan our spring workshop at Solomon Center if it is not in use that weekend. Meeting was adjourned.
