Upcoming Events:

1) PICNIC: Sunday, August 21st, our club will sponsor a picnic at Eagles Park in Tipp City. Maps will be provided. The club will furnish hot dogs and soft drinks. Bring a covered dish, place service for your family, and lawn chairs. It will begin at 2:00 P.M. with dinner at 5 O'clock. We can stay until 9:00 or 10:00 that evening. There are two charcoal grills, picnic tables, volley ball, basketball, baseball diamonds, and various other recreational facilities available.
