

FOURTH REGULAR MEETING OF MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCE COUNCIL

TIME: Tuesday evening, August 19, 1986 at 7:30

ATTENDING: Joanne Dombrowski, John Pappas, John Puterbaugh, Gitta Reck.

Secretary read minutes of previous meeting and they were approved. The treasurer reported \$1,706.24 in the treasury. We took in \$66.00 at the mini-workshop with Ercument Kilic on Aug. 16, 1986; \$33.00 from members and \$33.00 from non-members.

Ed Anderson agreed to accept \$110.00 for the expenses he incurred while making the listings for our dances.

John Pappas reported:

- 1) The MVFD did not go to the St. Joe Family Festival since not enough people signed up to dance.
- 2) Locks for the Pavilion have been changed again for all the doors; it appears golfers are using the place. We will have just 4 keys made for the new locks to be distributed among council and committee members.
- 3) A corrected list of members was sent to the folkdance directory.
- 4) A letter of recommendation was sent to Nicolaas Hilferink.
- 5) The completed questionnaire will be mailed to the Ohio representative of the National Folk Organization.
- 6) The Rowlands son has offered to fix the clubs mike for the price of the parts; he has not returned the mike yet.
- 7) Tri-City 1987 will be in Columbus. The dates are March 7, March 28 or April 4. We would prefer March 28 or April 4.

Fall Workshop, Nov. 8th and 9th with Ya'akov Eden. Joanne Dombrowski, Carol Pappas and Sandra Francis will Chair the workshop. Ja'akov will charge us \$300.00. Burkhardt Center will cost us only \$100.00. Joanne gave us the schedule and proposed fee for the workshop, council accepted her figures.
