She taught Polish language courses at Harvard, studied dance at the Boston Conservatory of Music and, for 17 years, taught dance and exercise classes at the Cambridge Center for Adult Education. For 9 years she was dance director and choreographer of the Boston Krakowiak Polish Dancers. In 1979 she and her family moved to Wisconsin, where she became, and still is, artistic director and choreographer for the Syrena Polish Folk Dance Ensemble. Since 1967 she has represented Poland in the nationwide recreational folk dance movement.


