

MIAMI VALLEY FOLK DANCERS

The Miami Valley Folk Dancers is a group of Miami Valley residents interested in international folk dancing. Members, whose ages range from the teens to the eighties, meet regularly for dancing in a friendly, relaxed atmosphere. Guests are always welcome. The group is sponsored by the City of Dayton.

Activities of the group include:

THURSDAY EVENING PROGRAMS

7:00 - 8:00 Orientation Class for all members, but especially for newcomers.

There is no formal curriculum as the teaching is tailored to the needs and desires of those participating. Attendance at 20 hours of this class is needed before full membership is accorded.

9:00 - 9:30 Teaching with instruction conducted by members.

8:00 - 9:00 Programmed and Request Dancing with a different member in charge 9:30 - close each week.

ETHNIC SUNDAY PROGRAMS

2:30 - 8:00 These are held on the second Sunday afternoon of each month.

Each program centers on a national or regional theme and the activities include teaching, request dancing, and dinner.

WORKSHOPS

Approximately two per year, spring and fall

These are weekend programs, each led by a recognized teacher of folk dancing. Many out-of-towners attend these programs which, in addition to teaching, include request dancing and dinner.

Anyone interested in folk dancing is eligible for associate membership. After 20 sessions of associate membership and concurrent participation in club-sponsored instruction (unless the associate member is already an accomplished folk dancer), full membership is accorded. Dues for associates are 50¢ per session and for full members they are \$1.00 per month. There is no charge for spectators.
