MVFD Council members:

I attended the regular meeting of the Miami Valley Dance Council on 9/9/97. Carolyn Stovall will send me complete minutes of the Dance Council meeting so I will be brief in my remarks here.

During the meeting John Roasa came down hard on the condition the Pavilion was being left in at closing. In particular, he cautioned members to be sure that

All ceiling fans have been turned off,
Gable fans have been turned off,
The floors have been swept, and
Trash has been picked up and the trash containers
have been emptied.

He strongly suggested that he will enforce the provisions of the rental agreement, even if it means some clubs may suffer by not being allowed to use the building.

Following the meeting I had short conversations with John and with Stuart Lewis.

John Roasa had previously indicated to me that there might be a change in the Pavilion rental, but he said that the rent we are now paying will be in effect until July, 1998, at least. At that time, if utility meters have been installed and the City of Dayton knows better the utility usage, there might be a rent change.

Stuart Lewis (454 0436) said the Miami Valley Callers Association is interested in knowing whether or not we would be interested in switching our use of the Pavilion from the second Sunday to the Third. Apparently the MVCA meets in the Pavilion on second Sunday mornings and has some type of dance program on the third Sunday afternoons and it would be more convenient for those members who travel some distance if both were held on the same day. (I failed to ask him why the morning meeting on the second Sunday couldn't be moved to the third Sunday.)

If we were to make such a swap, we would avoid the problem with Mother's Day conflicting with an Ethnic Sunday, but we would pick up the same problem with a conflict with Father's Day in June.
