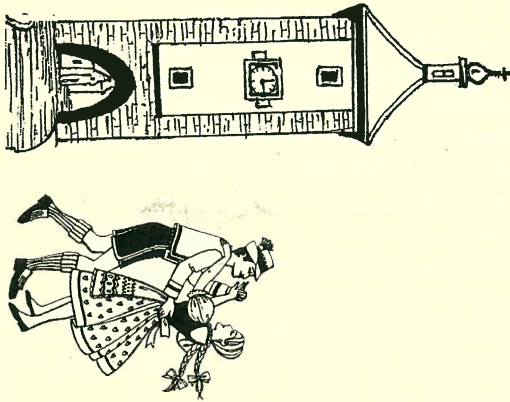

Directions to Lohrey Recreation Center (937-253-9511):

From Cincinnati - North I75 to East SR35

From Columbus - West I70 to South I675 to West SR 35

From SR 35, Exit Smithville Road , South

South on Smithville Road, 1.1 miles

Left on Highridge

Left on Glenarm and into rec center parking lot

Directions to Michael Solomon Pavilion (937-294-9357):

From I-675, Exit 10 (Dorothy Lane / Indian Ripple)

West on Dorothy Lane, approx 5 miles

Right on Berkley (Berkley will turn Left, and then Right)

Right on Central Park Ave, takes you into parking lot

Right on Central Park Ave, takes you into parking lot

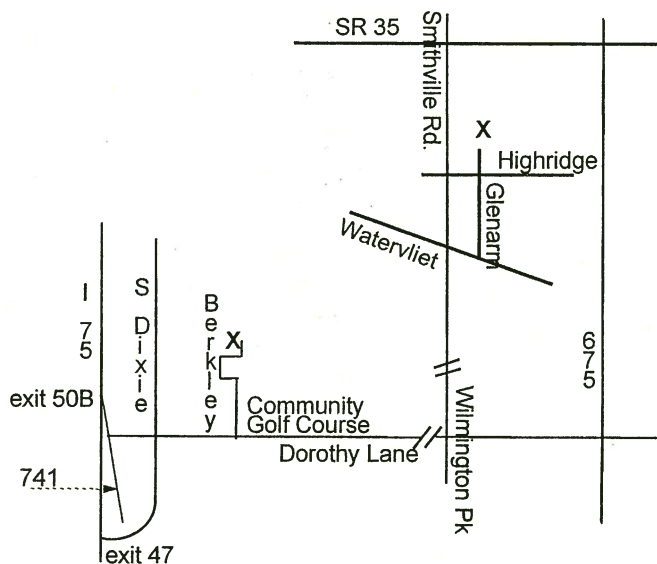
From Northbound 75, Exit 47 (W. Carrolton)
